<u>Learning From Experience (LFE)</u>

The most concerning incident involved a member of the public whose leg dropped through a gap in a low-level bridge on the Coastal Path. While the injured party was grazed and bruised, they had admitted to not paying attention when walking. The incident was swiftly dealt with, and a new bridge will be installed during the 24/25 winter.

2. Risk Assessment Management Plan (RAMP)

106 risk assessments were initially uploaded to the online folders in Teams, with a few additional documents added since August. All risk assessments have been given a unique reference number and are assigned to department heads to manage through their teams.

An informal meeting took place with the Astari auditor in September to provide an expert review of the risk assessment process and ensure that the risk assessments were compliant with their audit.

3. HAVS – Hand and Arm Vibration Syndrome Monitoring

The Authority have purchased the Reactec R-Link vibration monitoring equipment for each of the Wardens and some space capacity for Rangers or others who wish to monitor their HAVS exposure. This roll-out is expected to be completed by Christmas for winter equipment and March 2025 for the summer equipment.

Managers will be provided with some training by Reactec to understand how the online software system works.

4. Health and Safety Group

The Health and Safety Group minutes are attached from the meeting in July. The minutes of the October meeting are not yet available and will be reported to the next meeting of the Committee.

5. Health and Safety Internal Audits

It was hoped that the internal audits would be carried out in Q3 of 24/25, but the resignation of the Health and Safety Project Manager in October has stopped this work.

6. Training

First aid training for staff will be delivered before Christmas for those that need to ensure their competency remains in date.

Fire Warden training, including use of fire extinguishers, will be delivered before Christmas as well.
