# Funky Facts

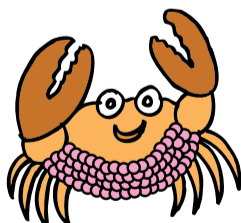
## We need a bigger bucket...

The biggest crab off the Pembrokeshire Coast is the Spiny Spider crab. It can measure over a metre between its outstretched claws.



### Punch-up

Crabs are very aggressive and often fight with each other. About 5% of crabs only have one claw.



### Happy families

A female crab can carry almost 200 000 eggs under her tummy before they hatch.

### Home sweet home

Hermit crabs make their home from an empty shell.

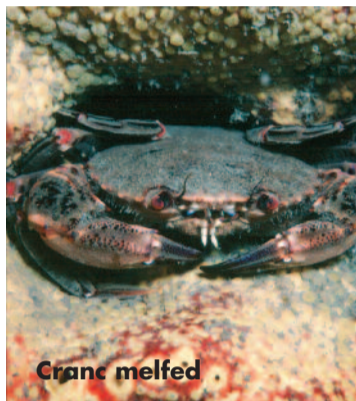

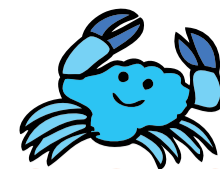

# Awgrymiadau Defnyddiol Top Tips

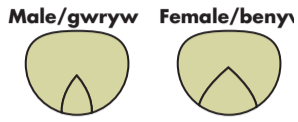
Daliwch y cranc gerfydd ochr y gragen fel nad oes modd iddo eich pinsio.



Hold crabs by the edge of the shell so they can't nip you.

Defnyddiwch lein gyda bag rhwyd bychan yn cynnwys bacwn neu ddarnau o bysgod neu gig arall ynddo.

Use a line with a small net bag containing bacon or other meat or fish bits.



Gallwch ddweud beth yw rhyw cranc trwy edrych ar y caead trionglog oddi tano.

You can tell the sex of a crab by looking at the triangular flap underneath.



Rhoddwch y crancod mewn bwced gyda digon o ddŵr a'u cadw allan o'r haul. Rhoddwch y crancod yn ôl yn y môr yn ofalus.

Put them in a bucket with plenty of water and out of the sun and return them carefully.

Byddwch yn daclus – ewch â'ch offer dala crancod i gyd gartref gyda chi.

Be tidy – take all your crabbing equipment home with you.



Yn Sir Benfro ceir milltiroedd ar filltiroedd o arfordir, nifer o harbyrau a cheiau cysgodol a phyllau trai arbennig, ble y dewch o hyd i wahanol grancod yn cuddio dan greigiau yn y rhan fwyaf o fannau y byddwch yn chwilio. Mae crancod bwytdwy'n un o ddanteithion Sir Benfro. Wedi diwrnod prysur yn dala crancod, beth am dynnu dŵr o'ch dannedd, a chefnogi'r economi lleol, trwy fwynhau brechdan flasus yn llawn cig cranc?

With miles of coastline, several sheltered harbours, quays and rockpools you'll find different crabs hiding everywhere you search. Edible crabs are a delicacy in Pembrokeshire. After an active day crabbing why not tempt your tastebuds and support the local economy by trying a yummy crab sandwich?



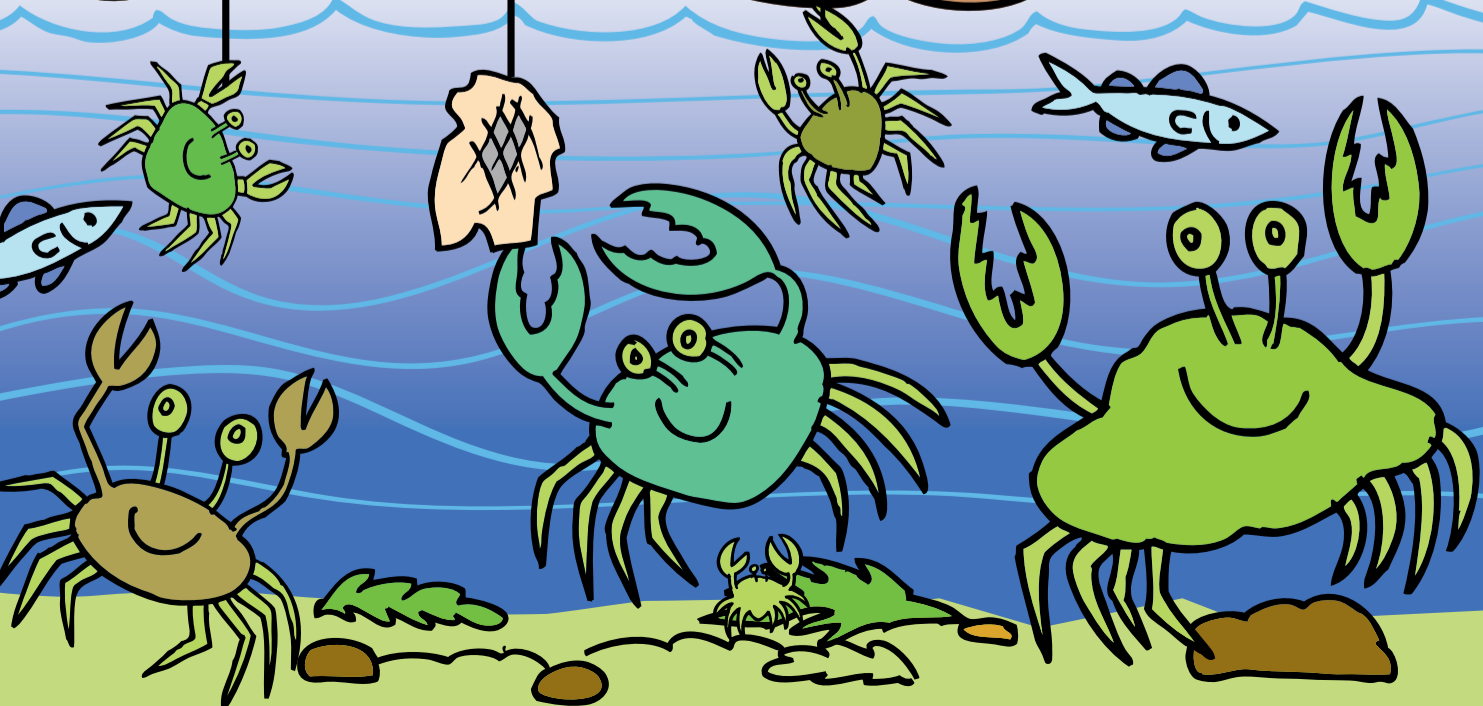
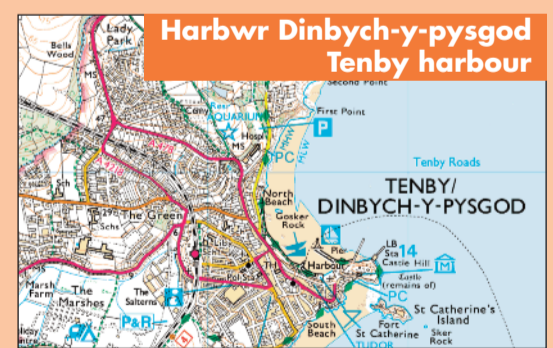

**Where and when**  
You will often see crabs in the rockpools around the coast, or you can go crabbing off a harbour wall. Look out for the empty shells crabs leave behind when moulting. The coast and marine life around Pembrokeshire are protected. If we look after them we can enjoy them now and for years to come.
